**M**embers at this historic 870-acre waterfront community enjoy a wealth of amenities, including two championship golf courses designed by Tom Fazio and Arthur Hills, a fitness center, a full-service marina, a resort-style pool complex, lively pickleball and tennis programs with eight Har-Tru courts, and an abundance of social activities. But this is a community whose generosity ripples far beyond its shores. For 40 years, Dataw residents have exemplified the spirit of good neighborliness, their commitment to service woven into the fabric of their community.

It's early morning at the Good Neighbor Medical Clinic of Beaufort, where a man sits awaiting care. He, like many others, relies on the clinic's volunteer staff, a significant portion of whom hail from Dataw Island. Sharon McElveen, who oversees administrative volunteers, attests to their invaluable contribution: "Nearly one in three of our 100-plus volunteers are Dataw residents." From doctors to nurses, administrative staff to the medical director himself, Dataw's presence is felt throughout the clinic.

This dedication to service isn't confined to healthcare. A recent survey revealed that a staggering 94 percent of Dataw residents volunteer their time and resources to over 65 non-profits and charitable organizations. Their efforts are diverse and far-reaching: supporting veterans, sewing quilts for children, organizing blood drives, and protecting sea turtle nests, to name just a few.

"They came and contributed—gave to our community, brought the arts to our community," McElveen reflects, highlighting the profound impact Dataw has had on Beaufort. They founded the Beaufort Symphony Orchestra, raised \$1.7 million for the area's first inpatient hospice, and continually support the Beaufort Memorial Hospital Foundation.

Dataw's legacy extends beyond financial contributions. They donated land for a fire station, helped fund a water treatment plant, and played a key role in establishing an \$11 million branch library. Today, Dataw residents continue to spend countless hours volunteering, their commitment unwavering.

Dataw Island stands as a testament to the power of community engagement, proving that good neighbors can truly make a world of difference.
